

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# **Dr. Jarred Dunn** *Adjudicator - Piano*

Jarred Dunn won first prize and concerto award at the 7th Lithuanian International Chopin Competition and is a prize winner of the 1st Jan Hoffman International Competition (Kraków). He won piano and chamber music prizes at the D. Vitti, Verona Zinetti, and Rome Premio International Competitions. He is described by critics as "evocative and mystical" (New York Classical Music),



"a piano sound-colour magician" (Muzikos Barai), "performer with exquisite pedalling" (Ludwig van Toronto), and "technically perfect" (Belarus First Radio). His critically-acclaimed discography includes Chopin and Debussy (AFA 2019), Brahms in Solitude (Yamaha 2022), Chopin's Diary: The Mazurkas (Lexicon 2024), and the complete H.M. Górecki piano solo and piano duo works, recorded alongside Górecki's daughter, Anna Górecka. His recordings have been heard on CBC, Classical 96.3FM, WWFM, WQXR, 98.7 WVMO, Belarusian First, and Madison Freethought Radio/TV. CBC featured him on This is My Music, Top Thirty Under Thirty, and Five Things I Learned From Maria João-Pires.

Mr. Dunn performs at renowned concert halls including Yamaha Performance Centre, NOSPR Katowice, Dvorana Hall, Klavierhaus Göttingen, Warsaw Chopin Museum, Vilnius Town Hall, Cavatina Hall, Isabel Bader Centre, Owen Arts Center, Opéra de Bordeaux, Chapelle du Bon-Pasteur Montréal, Juilliard School, etc. As a chamber musician he has performed with violinist Anna Kuk as Duo Mirage, in piano duo with Maria João-Pires, ATMA Quartet, served as collaborative pianist for Brahms Summer Festival (Austria), and is artist-faculty at Semaine International Piano et Musique de Chambre (Switzerland). He has appeared as concerto soloist with Vilnius, Lithuanian Chamber, Toruń, Budapest Chamber, Belarusian Radio, NOSPR, Toronto Sinfonia, York, and Niagara Symphonies, and others. He judges in national and international competitions, most recently the Lithuanian Chopin International, Global Musical Arts, Canadian National, FCMF, and OMFA competitions.

Noted by Tonebase Piano as a "revered pedagogue," Jarred Dunn gives masterclasses and workshops at The Juilliard School, SMU Meadows School of the Arts, Bydgoszcz Academy, Katowice Academy, Royal College of Music (London), Chetham's School, and many pre-colleges/universities in North America, Europe, and Australia. He teaches at McGill University Schulich School of Music. His teachers include Andrei Gavrilov, Maria João-Pires, Katarzyna Popowa-Zydroń, Anna Górecka, Andrzej Jasiński, Dorothy Taubman, Jacob Lateiner and Yoheved Kaplinsky. He is on the Alumni Committee of Aspen Music Festival and School and is a Yamaha Artist.



## **Dr. Michael Esch** *Adjudicator - Piano*

Michael Esch holds a Doctorate of Musical Arts Degree in Piano Performance from Rice University where his teachers included Robert Roux and Jon Kimura Parker. His other major influences include his first teachers, Rosemary Collins and Dorothy Morton, and coachings with Rebecca Penneys, Lazar Berman and Anton Kuerti.

Dr. Esch has been featured in numerous recitals throughout Canada including at the Glenn Gould Studio for the CBC, and for the Canadian University Music Society. He has also appeared in concerts throughout Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, the United States and Germany, as well as various centers in the far east. He has performed with numerous orchestras in Canada, and has collaborated with a number of acclaimed artists including the Belgian violinist Michael Guttman, the eminent violist, Rivka Golani, as well as many appearances with the Canadian Sinfonietta Chamber Players. The Canadian Composer Robert Rival has composed and dedicated the work '6 pieces for Piano' (found in the ARCT and LRCM repertoire lists) for Michael. Dr. Esch was a featured pianist on the RCME 2015 Piano Syllabus CD set and he is currently preparing several recording projects.

Michael has enjoyed grant support from the Chalmers Foundation, and is a multiple grant recipient from the Canada Council for the Arts. A sought after adjudicator in Canada, Michael has adjudicated festivals at the Provincial level for the O.M.F.A, ORMTA, SMFA, NSMFA, PABC, the Canadian Music Competition 50'th Anniversary National Tour, the Glenn Gould School Concerto Competition, the Cresendo, Conero, Classicalia International Piano Competitions among many others. He is a senior examiner for RCM examinations and is a regular masterclass clinician for the Phil and Eli Taylor Young Artist Performance Academy at the RCM.

A sought after teacher, Dr. Esch's students have been featured in major GTA recital venues including Koerner Hall, The Glenn Gould Studio, the University of Toronto Arts and Letters Club, Markham Theatre, as well as Carnegie Recital Hall in NYC. They have been featured in concert with important orchestras in Canada and Europe, received multiple listings on the CBC's Top 30 under 30 rankings, and in masterclasses with major artists in prestigious international music festivals such as the Morningside Music Bridge and John O'Conor's 'Beethoven Boot Camp'.


### Dr. Michael Esch

### Adjudicator - Piano

Recent achievements of Dr. Esch's students include: winner of the CFMTA National Piano Competition, CMC National Finalists, major prize winners in the ARD, Crescendo, GOCCA, Conero, Sound Espressivo Intls, winners of the ORMTA Young Artist Tour (4), National Gold Medal Winners for the RCM Licentiate Diploma (2), ARCT Gold Medal, the youngest candidate to have earned the RCM/LRCM with Distinction, recital tours with Jeunesse Musicales, as well as Prize Laureates at the Berlin and Boston Intl Amateurs competitions.

Dr. Esch has taught at Wilfrid Laurier University and has served on staff at the Glenn Gould School/RCM since 2007. In September of 2010 Michael and his wife opened the Esch Music Academy, a school for prodigious piano talent in Markham Ontario. Michael is a Top Teacher Award recipient from Steinway and Sons and was recently awarded a 2020 National Teacher of Distinction Award from the Royal Conservatory of Music. He will be a featured Guest Faculty at the inaugural 2023 Vancouver Piano Sessions.

Michael has served on Faculty at the University of Toronto since 2021.



# **Mr. Aljoša Jurinić** *Adjudicator - Piano*

Hailed as "a startlingly subtle and visionary pianist" with "a rare blend of charm and mastery", Croatian pianist Aljoša Jurinić has established himself as a laureate of the world's most prestigious piano competitions. Following his win at the 2012 International Robert Schumann Competition in the composer's hometown of Zwickau, he was a laureate at the 2016 Queen Elisabeth Piano



Competition and the 2018 Leeds International Piano Competition, as well as a finalist at the 2015 International Chopin Piano Competition in Warsaw.

Aljoša has appeared as a soloist and with orchestras at prominent venues in over 35 countries across five continents, including New York's Carnegie Hall, Wiener Musikverein, Salle Cortot in Paris, Gasteig in Munich, Tokyo Opera City Concert Hall, Osaka Symphony Hall, La Sala Verdi in Milan, BOZAR in Brussels, Lisinski Concert Hall in Zagreb, and many others. In addition, he held several solo recital tours in China and Japan.

His discography includes five albums featuring works by Chopin, Schumann, and Debussy. The latest album, Correspondances (2020) for KNS Classical, will be succeeded by a new release in late 2024. A sought-after chamber musician, Aljoša has collaborated with world-renowned instrumentalists such as Kian Soltani, Luka Šulić, and Petrit Çeku, to name a few. In 2019, the president of Croatia awarded him the Order of the Morning Star for outstanding achievements in culture and the international promotion of his country.

His education includes Croatia, Austria, Italy, Germany, and Canada, where he is a doctoral candidate (DMA) at the University of Toronto. Based in Boston, USA, Aljoša combines performing and teaching with research on the biomechanics of piano playing as a Visiting Artist at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology's Immersion Lab.



# **Dr. Younggun Kim** *Adjudicator - Piano*

Younggun Kim is a pianist known for his blazing technical capacity and a lush sound supported by a natural phrasing sense (Timothy Gilligan, New York Concert Review), who has performed across North America and Europe. He is active as concerto soloist, recitalist, and chamber musician, and he teaches at the University of Toronto. Younggun has also been closely involved with the Health Arts Society (Concerts

in Care) since 2011, playing in their concert series for those who may find it difficult to visit conventional venues.

His recent performances highlights include a solo appearance with Toronto Korean-Canadian Choir/Orchestra playing Beethoven's Choral Fantasy, solo recital as a part of Faculty Artist Series at Queen's University, a duo recital with Sophie Dervaux who is a member of the Vienna Philharmonic, an appearance with the esteemed Isabel Quartet performing Robert Schumann's Quintet, a concerto performance with Niagara Symphony as well as recital engagements in Seoul, Korea.

Younggun is the winner of various prizes including San Antonio International Competition, Concours International de Piano Francis Poulenc, and Doctor of Musical Arts Recital Competition at the University of Toronto. Upon completion of the doctoral degree, Younggun was chosen as the recipient of the Tecumseh Sherman Rogers Graduating Award, which is the largest award offered by the Faculty of Music.

He is a Toronto-based Canadian from South Korea. After changing his career path in his early twenties from French literature to music, Younggun finished his undergraduate degree at the Glenn Gould School of the Royal Conservatory of Music, Master's Degree at Peabody Institute of Johns Hopkins University, and the Doctor of Musical Arts Degree at the University of Toronto. He studied with renowned artists such as Boris Slutsky and the late Marietta Orloy.

# Mr. Martin MacDonald Adjudicator - Concerto Classes

Martin MacDonald is one of Canada's most dynamic and outstanding conductors and has been awarded both the Heinz Unger Award and the Jean-Marie Beaudet Award for orchestral conducting. In January 2022, Martin was named Music Director of the Cathedral Bluffs Symphony Orchestra based in Toronto, Ontario. Most recently, Martin was named Artistic Partner of the Brott Music Festival based in



Hamilton, Ontario where he will conduct several programs throughout the 2024 summer and fall season. Martin has guest conducted extensively across Canada having worked with the orchestras of Toronto, National Arts Centre, Vancouver, Victoria, Kamloops, Edmonton, Calgary, Regina, Saskatoon, Winnipeg, Hamilton, Kingston, Kitchener-Waterloo, London, Niagara, Sudbury, Thunder Bay, Windsor, Quebec, New Brunswick, and Newfoundland. He has served as a Cover and Guest Conductor for the National Ballet of Canada for several productions, and has worked with the Minnesota Ballet, Atlantic Ballet, and Halifax Dance. Martin has recorded extensively for the CBC and for several commercial recordings. Most notably, Martin has served as Resident Conductor, Associate Conductor, and a regular guest conductor of Symphony Nova Scotia since 2008 with over 200 performances in a diverse range of programs and artists. Previously, Martin served as Associate Conductor of the National Academy Orchestra of Canada, and has participated in several international conducting workshops and competitions. Recently, Martin has led several live orchestra to film productions and has produced orchestral and opera livestreams and recordings for the Toronto Symphony Orchestra and Against the Grain Theatre.

Martin has a Master's degree in Orchestral Conducting from McGill University. At McGill, he studied conducting with Alexis Hauser, served as assistant conductor to the McGill Symphony Orchestra, and worked with both Opera McGill and the McGill Contemporary Music Ensemble as well as several other orchestral and chamber music activities. Martin has a Bachelor's degree in Cello from Memorial University. Martin further studied conducting with Bernhard Gueller, Boris Brott, and Michael Jinbo; and in workshops with Kenneth Kiesler, Gustav Meier, Jorma Panula, and Johannes Schlaefli. Martin's conducting activities have been generously supported by the Canada Council for the Arts. As a cellist, Martin has performed extensively with many orchestras and chamber music ensembles throughout Canada.

Cape Breton born, Martin is the youngest of twelve children and has a diverse musical background with a strong Celtic music tradition including extensive touring and performing with members of his family throughout Europe and North America. Martin resides in Toronto, Ontario with his wife, Kristen and their daughter, Frances.



# **Dr. Emma Schmiedecke** *Adjudicator - Strings*

Praised for her "huge musicality, depth of interpretation, and technical expertise" (Manhattan International Music Competition), cellist Emma Schmiedecke has established herself as a vibrant interpreter of both the classical and contemporary cello repertoire. As guest soloist, Emma has performed with the Woodstock Chamber Orchestra, Bergen Philharmonic, and Bravura Philharmonic, and performed in masterclasses for

Steven Isserlis, Colin Carr, Raphael Wallfisch, David Geringas, Leon Fleisher, and Arnold Steinhardt, among others. As a chamber musician, she has been mentored by artists including Ida Kavafian, Levon Chilingirian, Daniel Phillips, Scott St. John, Duo Concertante, the Gryphon Trio, and the Shanghai Quartet. Emma has appeared at Ottawa Chamberfest and Big Lake Chamber Music Festival with the Continuum HATCH Contemporary Ensemble, and has been a visiting artist at The Banff Centre, the Centre d'Arts Orford, the Toronto Summer Music Festival, Domaine Forget de Charlevoix Chamber Music Festival, Vermont Mozart Festival, Atlantic Music Festival, the Heifetz Institute, the Round Top Festival Institute, the Tafelmusik Baroque Summer Institute, the NYU Steinhardt String Quartet Seminar, and the Oxford Cello School in Oxford, England. Select awards and prizes include a Silver Medal in the Professional Category of the 4th Manhattan International Music Competition, the Temerty Family Foundation Scholarship, the Mai Why and Peter Levitt Graduate Scholarship, the Clive Allen Fellowship, the Denise Ireland & Harry Underwood Fellowship, the Ingeborg and Angela Kramer Award, a McGill University Graduate Dean's Award, and first prize in the Bravura Philharmonic and Bergen Philharmonic Young Artist Competitions.

A dedicated teacher, Emma teaches at the Lane School of Music and the University of Toronto, was a teaching artist in cello for the Orchestra of St. Luke's Youth Orchestra & Music Education Program and Sistema Toronto, and has been a chamber music coach at the Glenn Gould School of the Royal Conservatory of Music and its pre-college program, the Phil and Eli Taylor Performance Academy for Young Artists. Emma holds a Doctor of Music in Cello Performance from the University of Toronto School of Music, and she obtained both a Master of Music and Graduate Diploma in Cello Performance from the Schulich School of Music of McGill University. She also holds an Artist Diploma from the Glenn Gould School of the Royal Conservatory of Music, a Bachelor of Music from the Bard College Conservatory of Music, and a Bachelor of Arts in Art History from Bard College, all magna cum laude. Her primary teachers include Peter Wiley, Matt Haimovitz, Yegor Dyachkov, Desmond Hoebig, Andrés Diaz, Sophie Shao, Luis Garcia-Renart, André Emelianoff, Bjørn Bantock, and Jonathan Spitz.

- CCCTIMF Grand Trophy winner(s) and the Concerto Class winners are automatically eligible to be considered for the concert soloist engagement. No registration is required.
- All Online classes will not be considered for this opportunity.
- Cathedral Bluffs Symphony Orchestra's Music Director may select one or more soloist(s) from the winner pool for a concert soloist engagement.
- The selection criteria may not be based on the marks of the winners but on other criteria such as the suitability of the repertoire for the Cathedral Bluffs Symphony Orchestra's concert programming.
- If no soloists are selected from the current festival, the CCCTIMF organizing committee may recommend previous festival winners for the concerto performance engagement for the Cathedral Bluffs Symphony Orchestra's consideration in their concert season.
- · Cathedral Bluffs Symphony Orchestra Music Director's decision is considered final.


